

Credit Equivalents Process

NZQA

This process is completed by the school on behalf of the student when and if they require credits toward the NCEA. Students should wait until NCEA results are available and if they require the extra credits to complete the NCEA at any one level, contact their school to make the application on their behalf.

1. Fill out the form “CREDIT INCLUSION: REPORTING STUDENT RESULTS” using the example as your guide.
2. Send this form and a copy of the Young Enterprise Trust results to NZQA. The address is at the bottom of the form.
3. NZQA will notify you that the Credit Equivalents have been received and processed.

To do this paper, the school needs to be registered with NZIM.

1. Complete the form from NZIM and include the Young Enterprise Trust results with it.
2. NZIM will send a statement of achievement with a note that records the NCEA Credit equivalents for the certificate papers.
