Student Review Statement One

Section A: Company Vision/Mission Statement

1. Identify and discuss your YES Company's vision and/or mission statement.

The vision or the mission statement must be clearly identified and discussed. Discussion references should be consistent with the mission or vision statement and the company's prospectus or business plan.

2. How can you personally help your company achieve the vision and/or mission statement?

*This may be through a specific role e.g. Marketing Director or a general role. At least two explanatory sentences are required. Each sentence should clearly identify how the student expects to help the company achieve the vision or mission statement. The vision and/or mission statements are those referred to in question one. The explanation must relate to the vision/mission statements **and** the company.*

3. Identify what you want to achieve by being a member of your YES Company?

*At least **two** personal goals should be identified. The goals can be specific to the student's personal development requirements and specifically relate to the student's activities in Young Enterprise. The enterprise attributes and skills may be used to describe personal goals.*

Section B: Your Role – Personal tasks

4. Identify and then describe at least two tasks you have done so far in your Young Enterprise Company this year.

The student should clearly identify two separate tasks. For each task, the student should then describe how the task was carried out and the extent of its completion. The tasks can be straightforward and should be at a responsible level.

5. Illustrate how the tasks you undertook contributed to your directorship role and the operation of your YES Company.

The explanations of the contributions for each task must be relevant, appropriate and show understanding. The tasks are those referred to in question four.

6. Explain at least two challenges you faced in carrying out your role and how they arose.

Challenge	Explanation
<i>The student should identify and explain at least two challenges. The challenges should demonstrate a level of responsibility.</i>	<i>The student should explain how at least two challenges arose. The challenges referred to are those in the first part of this question.</i>
