### **The Lion Foundation Young Enterprise Scheme Company of the Year**

*Awarded to the YES company placed first overall. Open to all Regional Champions, chosen by a panel of judges at the YES National Final in Wellington.*

The winning company receives a \$3000 cash prize and a trophy.

The winning school receives a \$2000 cash prize for a project.

Each member of the winning company receives a \$5000 scholarship for the Massey University Business School.



### **The Sir John Todd Memorial Award**

*Awarded to the YES company placed second overall. Open to all Regional Champions, chosen by a panel of judges at the YES National Final in Wellington.*

The 2<sup>nd</sup> placed company receives a \$2000 cash prize and a trophy.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> placed school receives a \$1000 cash prize.



### **The Todd Foundation Award**

*Awarded to the YES company placed third overall. Open to all Regional Champions, chosen by a panel of judges at the YES National Final in Wellington.*

The 3<sup>rd</sup> placed company receives a \$1000 cash prize and a trophy.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> placed school receives a \$1000 cash prize.



## Excellence Awards

### **BP Award for Social Enterprise**

*Companies who recognise social challenges and use entrepreneurial principles to organise, manage and create a positive change in the community will be considered for this award. Evidence must be shown in the Annual Review.*

The winning company receives a \$1000 cash prize.



### **Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand Award for CEO of the Year**

*Awarded to the YES CEO who most effectively demonstrates leadership. Judging will be based on the CEO's statement about their leadership excellence - up to 500 words as to why you should be considered.*

The winning student receives a \$1000 cash prize and a trophy.
