The InEx board game teaches students about budgeting in a fun and engaging way, showing them how to live their lives as well as they can within their budget. Students earn wages and must calculate how to save and spend their earnings. The game can be played in one session, or over several lessons.

Student learning

Through InEx, students will:

- Learn about fixed, variable and discretionary expenses
- Make decisions about how to allocate their money against different expenses while still saving
- Learn how to create and maintain a weekly budget
- Understand the disadvantages of going into debt
