

# Junior Enterprise Challenge



## Introduction

This experiential programme introduces groups of 60 primary and intermediate students to enterprise and financial capability. Teams of students create products and services to be sold to parents, teachers and students at a market day. Financial education is woven into the programme, which uses activities, games and quizzes to help learning. Students track their learning in a journal.

## Student Learning


Through Junior Enterprise Challenge, students will:

- › Learn about earning, spending, saving and sharing
- › Improve their financial capability and decisionmaking skills
- › Work as a team to produce and present small products and services.

## Curriculum Links

The Junior Enterprise Challenge is a highly crosscurricular programme. It has a strong focus on the Economic World strand of the Social Sciences Curriculum. It also uses skills from the Technology, The Arts, English and Mathematics and Statistics curriculum areas.
