

Top Dog webquest

The 'Top Dog' webquest challenges students to research the costs of owning a dog. This online activity requires students to make decisions based on selection criteria that are either chosen by students or provided in the unit. Students then calculate the financial costs, which are based on their research. Students can complete the 'Top Dog' webquest in groups or individually.





Student learning

Through the 'Top Dog' webquest, students will:

- Learn to research and analyse information before making financial decisions
- Be able to articulate the financial consequences of their decisions

The 'Top Dog' webquest tests students' financial capabilities. It has links to the 'Economic World' strand of the Social Sciences curriculum. The unit also focuses on the 'Number and Algebra' and 'Geometry and Measurement' strands of the Mathematics and Statistics curriculum.
